Apprentice Electricians work under the supervision and direction of a Journeyman and will assist across several areas, such as installation, alteration, addition, and/or repair of electrical systems within commercial environments.

Duties will include:

- Report to worksite on time and ready to work.
- Read blueprints and interpret wiring diagrams and schematics.
- Install, troubleshoot and repair of electrical systems.
- Measure, cut, bend wire and conduit using a hand bender.
- Help in mounting and strapping conduit.
- Gather supplies and tools to be used at project work sites.
- Assist in pulling wire, lifting, hoisting and positioning materials.
- Installation of j-boxes, panels, cable trays, Unistrut, support structures, indoor/outdoor lighting, receptacles, switches, motor controls, switch gears.
- Utilize power tools, saws, threaders, and knockout punches and operation of two handed tools/equipment, cable cutters, hammer drills and compression tools.
- Operate and work from mechanical personnel lifts, both electric and gasoline powered.
- Verify compliance and functionality of installations.
- Maintain workflow schedule to ensure productivity objectives are met.
- Adhere to all safety policies and ensure that safety is paramount on all job sites.
- Other duties as assigned.
